



Fact Sheet & Registration Information for Grades Pre-K through 8th Grade

We are a Catholic elementary school educating children from Nursery through Grade 8. School hours are as follows:

Nursery:

We offer a Morning Session (8:00am – 11:00am) or Full Day (8:00am – 2:30pm)
Two Day Program – Monday and Tuesday
Three Day Program – Wednesday, Thursday, Friday
Five Day Program – Monday through Friday

Pre-Kindergarten:

Morning Program – Monday through Friday 8:00am – 11:15am
Full Day Program- Monday through Friday 8:00am – 2:40pm

Kindergarten

Monday through Friday 8:00am – 2:50pm

Grades 1-8

Monday through Friday 8:00 – 3:00pm

Tuition Fee for Nursery:

There is a special discount for our families that have an older child(ren) in an upper grade that are registering a Nursery student - \$250.00/\$500.00 full day discount.

Tuition Fee for Grades Pre-Kindergarten through 8th Grade:

We have two tuition rates for student entering Pre-K through 8th Grade and they are as follows:

-Affiliated: Affiliated is defined as a Catholic family (child and one parent must be baptized Catholics) who is registered in a Parish, attends Sunday Liturgy regularly and who contributes regularly to their Parish using the Sunday envelopes. A contribution of \$10.00 per week is required of all Immaculate Conception Parish Families with children in the school if they are to qualify for the Affiliated rate.

-Non-Affiliated: Non Affiliated is defined as Catholic families who are not, or choose not to be, active participating members as defined above OR Non-Catholic families.

Registration Requirements:

Your child **MUST** be present during registration and you must bring the following:

1. A completed registration form with the required signatures.
2. A Registration fee of \$250.00 per family– **Non-refundable**.
3. Your child’s Birth Certificate - Age requirements are as follows:
 - Nursery children must be 3 years of age by 12/31/2011
 - Pre-Kindergarten must be 4 years of age by 12/31/2011
 - Kindergarten must be 5 years of age by 12/31/2011
4. Your child’s Baptismal Certificate.
5. Written proof of your child’s vaccinations (your child’s immunization booklet).
6. If you wish to be considered for Affiliated status and are an active member of a Catholic parish, please bring an “extra” of your most recent church envelopes. **(THIS ONLY APPLIES TO FAMILIES REGISTERING CHILDREN IN GRADES PRE-KINDERGARTEN THROUGH 8TH GRADE.)**
7. For Grades 2 through 7 **ONLY:**
 - Your child’s most recent report cards (if you are submitting a copy, please give us a copy of both sides)
 - Your child’s most recent standardized Math and Reading scores.
 - First Communion Certificate (if child has received the Sacrament).
 - First Penance Certificate (if child has received the Sacrament).
 - Confirmation Certificate (if child has received the Sacrament).

Special Note: We offer an After School Program that can be used on a regular or an “as needed” basis. The hours are from dismissal each day to 6:00pm. The rates are:

\$20.00 Daily per child----- \$75.00 Weekly per child

We also have a Before-School Program that enables parents to bring their children to school as early as 7:30am. Students stay in the program until the school doors open at 8:00am. The rates are:

\$2.00 daily per child-----7:30am to 8:00am
